- Involvement of more kids through schools, for adults clear strategy (e.g. no tournament outside, or it should be renamed windminton) and sponsor involvement.
 - ein langsamerer Einstiegs-Speeder wäre schön, für Anfänger sind die roten Speeder nicht spielbar
 - less trouble with organisation of tournaments (the rules and guidelines currently do not encourage oneself to organise an official tournament)
- Players in 3rd and 4th place in a tournament need to get different points (might be established already, not sure right now)
- Speedminton needs to charge less money per speeder
- Speedminton needs to provide more colors for balls and courts (because a lot of tennis courts and indoor courts are colored yellow/orange/beige which impairs visibility heavily. This is one of our greatest problems and members have left the sport because of this).

A concept contains information about the people that play, how many are managers, doctors etc what ages groups etc. Also the healthy aspect is very important especially in the health boom today. Squash has been dropping for this reason. We need sponsors as in other sports and have to give large companies the title sponsorship if they are prepared to support events.

Realistically all players at the world championships are losing money by playing there and this is a joke and makes crossminton unique in a negative way! A ideal game for airlines to sponsor ☐ Or power with car producers as an aspect. This is where information about the nationalities. Jobs, ages etc are needed to give potential sponsors a feedback. Olympic has to be the final aim really.

- The restricted time for training. for instance I used trained on friday afternoon from 4:30 to 6: 00 p.m at the Sir Abdool Raman Osman Gymnasium at Phoenix. Unfortunately I have to stop due to school tuition same time same day. It would have been great if I could have trained some other time and day.

- Big sponsorship deals on the highest level. Money makes the people pay attention to anything. More sponsors means more money, more money means more prizes, more prizes means more players, more players means better quality. Better quality bring supporters, and more supporters is what this sport needs to become a big thing. Ultimately, we need several hundred or thousand supporters (not players) on European and World championships. Supporters that would pay to watch Per or Jasmina battle with the others...

- Because of its recreational nature, crossminton is seen as mainly hobby activity. The advantage became a

dissadvantage. More media coverage and sponsored professional players might be the solution.

- Rackets S400 was broke their strings very quickly, need to have more elastic protectors between aluminium racket base and string. It is impossible to get strings in Russia, need to use squash strings instead.
Rings of court must be as weight as 100g (we use self made court instead with 1..2-inches nut as rings) to prevent movement under wind. But I am afraid such ring may cause court will be broken.
May be something like 12.8 meters length wire in kit complects to ensure courts distance is correct (and to get volans sucked in trees back).
