Remember: All players must have a valid ICO licence. Players in ICO member countries have to be registered by the ICO member.

Sponsoring support for ICO tournaments will be calculated on the following allocate formula:

100 % SPONSORSHIP ightarrow 90%-100% POINTS ACHIEVED

80 % SPONSORSHIP ightarrow 80%-90% POINTS ACHIEVED

60 % SPONSORSHIP ightarrow 70%-80% POINTS ACHIEVED

40 % SPONSORSHIP ightarrow 60%-70% POINTS ACHIEVED

20 % SPONSORSHIP ightarrow 50%-60% POINTS ACHIEVED

0 % SPONSORSHIP ightarrow 0%-49% POINTS ACHIEVED

There is at least 1 independent observer on each tournament.

Tournament standards are supervised by the ICO Board members, who make a final report about achieved %.
